Buddy network is intended to be at hand before your arrival and during your stay to make it as easy as possible. A buddy will contact you before you arrive and provide you with all the information you may need. Do not hesitate to ask them a question if you are in doubt about something.

Currency: the only official currency in Serbia is Serbian Dinar (RSD). Exchange rate is, at the moment, approximately 119 dinars = 1€, but the rate varies.

Mobile Phone numbers: the three official service providers are Telekom Srbija (<http://www.mts.telekom.rs>) , Telenor (<http://www.telenor.rs/en/Consumer>) and VIP (<http://www.vipmobile.rs/home.8.html>) . The SIM cards can be bought either at the registered provider directly or at any news stand in the city.

Internet: Broadband internet access is widely available (cable, ADSL, wireless) but it depends on your accommodation (ask for details). Prices and speeds are changing. There are several internet cafes and faculties have their own computer rooms, and more and more places in the city where free wireless is provided by the city. Users of **EDUROAM** can also use it on the University campus (www.eduroam.org).

Grading system: A 5-10 grading scale is used at the University of Novi Sad (with 6 as a pass level). Within the higher education system of the Republic of Serbia, Student's success is assessed by grades from 5 (failed) to 10 (excellent).
