Campus of International Excellence: CEI BioTic Granada

The BioTic Granada Campus is a project based on four major strategic areas worthy of recognition for their international excellence: BioHealth; Information Communications Technology (ICT, or TIC in Spanish); Earth System; and Heritage and Culture. Of these, it focuses on the first two, BioHealth and ICT. The project is underpinned by an extensive Strategic Partnership whose highest level of participation is made up of the UGR, the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC), and the Health-Science Technology Park (PTS).
