INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

In general

- 94 university level agreements in around 30 different countries on 4 continents
- Another 70 faculty level agreements

- 4.074 graduates per year, including 123 MSc and 55 PhD
- 210 study programs

MOBILITY PROGRAMS

Erasmus Mundus – JoinEU SEE

- 2011/2012 – 20 incoming student mobilities, 4 incoming staff mobilities
- 2011/2012 – 6 outgoing student mobilities, 2 outgoing staff mobilities
- 2012/2013 – 28 incoming student mobilities, 2 incoming staff mobilities
- 2012/2013 – 10 outgoing student mobilities, 3 outgoing staff mobilities

Erasmus
